<i>Lectures</i> Civil Defense - conceptual definition; development, mission, goals, tasks, structure, organization, management and systematization of modern civil defense systems; the civil defense system of Serbia; concept, goals, functions, tasks, organization and structure of the civil defense system in Republic Serbia; methodology of management, planning and preparation of civil defense systems; professional training in the civil defense system and the direction of further development of the civil defense system in our country and in the world.			
<i>Practice classes</i> Analysis of concrete organizational solutions of modern civil defense systems in individual countries of the contemporary world; designing individual plan documents that form the country's defense plan.
