<b>Teaching course objective:</b> The aim of studying this course contents is to acquire general and expert knowledge on the ways of organizing, their functioning, and managing modern civil protection systems with a focus on the civil protection system of Republic Serbia.			
<b>Teaching course outcome:</b> The ability of students to organize, plan and implement measures for the protection and rescue of population, material and cultural goods and the environment in emergency situations in times of peace and in war conditions.			
<b>Contents of the course</b>			
<i>Lectures</i> Introduction to the subject: mission, objectives, functions, and tasks of civil protection; the emergence and development of civil protection in the world and in our country; international frameworks for cooperation and strengthening of civil protection systems; civil protection of Republic Serbia; objectives, functions, tasks and principles of civil protection; Arcane and reciprocal protection; protection and rescue measures; civil protection units; managing and decision making in the civil protection system; planning the use of civil protection; role of civil protection in the protection and rescue from elementary and other major disasters; measures for preventing and eliminating the consequences of technical and technological accidents; measures for the preservation and protection of cultural goods from destruction or plunder; training in the civil protection system; the direction of further development of the civil protection system in Serbia and in the world.			
<i>Practice classes</i> Training to be able to make a vulnerability assessment and individual civil protection plan documents. Visiting companies, organizations and services of special interest for protection and rescue.
