<i>Lectures</i> Principles of criminalistics, indications, versions, criminalistic measures and actions, criminalistic control and processing, proving actions, methods of detecting, explicating and proving certain criminal offenses, application of natural and technical sciences methods in crime prevention and suppression.			
<i>Practice classes</i> Analysis of completed criminal investigations and simulations of criminalistic-tactical situations for crimes of general and economic criminality.
