<b>Contents:</b>			
<i>Theory</i> In this part of the course, students are introduced to the theoretical features of the public sector of society, public administration institutions, local self-governments and enterprises and institutions of public importance. Since these are organizations of vital importance for each society, their functioning is also studied in the context of state administration and profiling the interests of national security in their work. Emphasis is placed on the importance and role of management approach in the promotion or introduction of changes in the work of organizations and institutions of the public sector.			
<i>Practice</i> In the practical part of the course students practically apply the adopted theoretical knowledge by making an analysis of the work of representative examples of public sector organizations.
