Contents of the course			
<i>Lectures</i> In this part of the course, students are introduced to the theoretical and methodological bases and characteristics of management as a scientific field dealing with the phenomena of achieving organized human activity. Management of the planning, decision making, control, and managing functions is especially studied. In addition, the emphasis is also on considering the various roles of managers as well as the characteristics and importance of team work for the successful application of theoretical principles of management.			
<i>Practice classes</i> In the practical part of the course, students practically apply the acquired theoretical knowledge analyzing different forms of organizations and institutions.
