Contents of the course <i>Theoretical work (Lectures)</i> Etiology of jeopardizing - natural hazards and risks, technical and technological hazards and risks, war threats and contemporary security challenges, risks and threats; emergency situations and their consequences; protection and rescue system - conceptual determination; mission, goals, tasks of modern systems of protection and rescue; international frameworks of cooperation in the area of civil emergency planning; organization and structure of the protection and rescue system in the Republic of Serbia; the legal basis of the protection and rescue system; subjects of the protection and rescue system - the government sector, the non-governmental sector and economic and other legal entities; management, protection and rescue system planning and preparation; civil-military cooperation; training and enabling in the protection and rescue system and the directions of further development of the protection and rescue system in our country and in the world. <i>Practice classes</i> Analysis of concrete organizational solutions of modern protection and rescue systems in different countries of the contemporary world; preparation and presentation of seminar papers; preparation for the first and second knowledge testing - colloquiums.
