Teaching course objective: The goal of studying Emergency Management is to acquire knowledge about the process and emergency managing system, as well as to professionally and qualitatively assess the threats and vulnerability and to develop emergency protection and rescue plans.			
Teaching course outcome: By studying contents of this course, students gain professional competencies for: the assessment of natural and technogenic (anthropogenic) risks; emergency managing at all stages of its manifestation; managing the necessary resources for emergencies and developing emergency response plans and rescue plans.			
Contents of the course			
<i>Lectures</i> Concept, process and emergency managing system; basic characteristics of the emergency managing system.; risk managing methodology by stages of emergency situation: pre-emergence phase, phase during manifestation of emergency and phase after emergency. Modular emergency managing system; the methodology of assessing vulnerability; drafting and content of protection and rescue plans for emergency situations; Formal and non-formal education in the function of emergency management.			
<i>Practice classes</i> Development of vulnerability risk assessment methodology - risk assessment and analysis, and designing the individual plan documents and protection and rescue emergency plan.
