Study course outcome: Knowledge about different disciplinary modes of approaching the study of the phenomenon of social conflicts. Understanding the complexity of the phenomenon of conflict in the context of contemporary relationships in the international community.			
Contents of the course			
<i>Lectures</i> The course Theories of conflict presupposes getting acquainted with the concept and nature of conflict, the causes of its emergence, as well as the elements, phases, dynamics and outcomes of social conflicts. The basic methods of resolving intra-state and interstate conflict issues are also being addressed.			
<i>Practice classes</i> In the practical part of the course students have the opportunity to deepen the acquired theoretical knowledge in order to investigate the actual conflicts in contemporary society and post-conflict situations in our region.
