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Foreword

All curricula implemented at the Faculty of Security focus on national, strategic, environmental, and corporate security studies. Together they form an integral part of the corpus of security science – scientific fields within the social science and humanities that have undergone intensive development and affirmation in recent decades. This trend we can see very clearly when looking at study programmes at major universities in the world: from Europe and the United States, through Russia and China, all the way to Australia or the Middle East, the importance of education and research in the field of security science is recognizable everywhere.

Relying on its own, as well as relevant international experience, the Faculty has arranged the subject contents of undergraduate, master, and doctoral studies covering the following areas within security sciences:

1. **Studies of national security** (internal security of the state; stability of the legal order, the fight against organized crime, terrorism, corruption, and other types of social and political pathology);
2. **Strategic security studies** (external security of the state; studies of defence, geopolitics, international relations, etc.);
3. **Corporate security studies** (business security; human resources and legal, socio-psychological, information and physical-technical aspects of security companies/corporations);
4. **Studies of environmental security and emergencies** (security of natural resources; prevention, monitoring, and implementing protection of people and material goods due to natural disasters and catastrophes).

Faculty of Security Studies organizes “**Security Risk Assessment**,” specialist professional studies in cooperation with Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, University of Belgrade, and “**Forensics**,” specialist professional studies with the Faculty for Physical Chemistry, University of Belgrade.

The Faculty organizes “**Training of personal data protection managers**,” a BRIEF programme of studies together with *the Commissioner for Information of Public Importance and Personal Data Protection*.

The security science academic legitimacy acquisition begins with overcoming the role of up to then discursive pendant in military and police protection training. Contrary to such beginnings, we know today that “being a security officer” means being a broadly and thoroughly educated expert and not a well-trained soldier or policeman. Higher, i.e., university-level of dealing with security implies ac-

quiring knowledge from a wide range of established humanities that are amended and redesigned by focusing on various thematic areas – from state defence and personal security to nature protection.

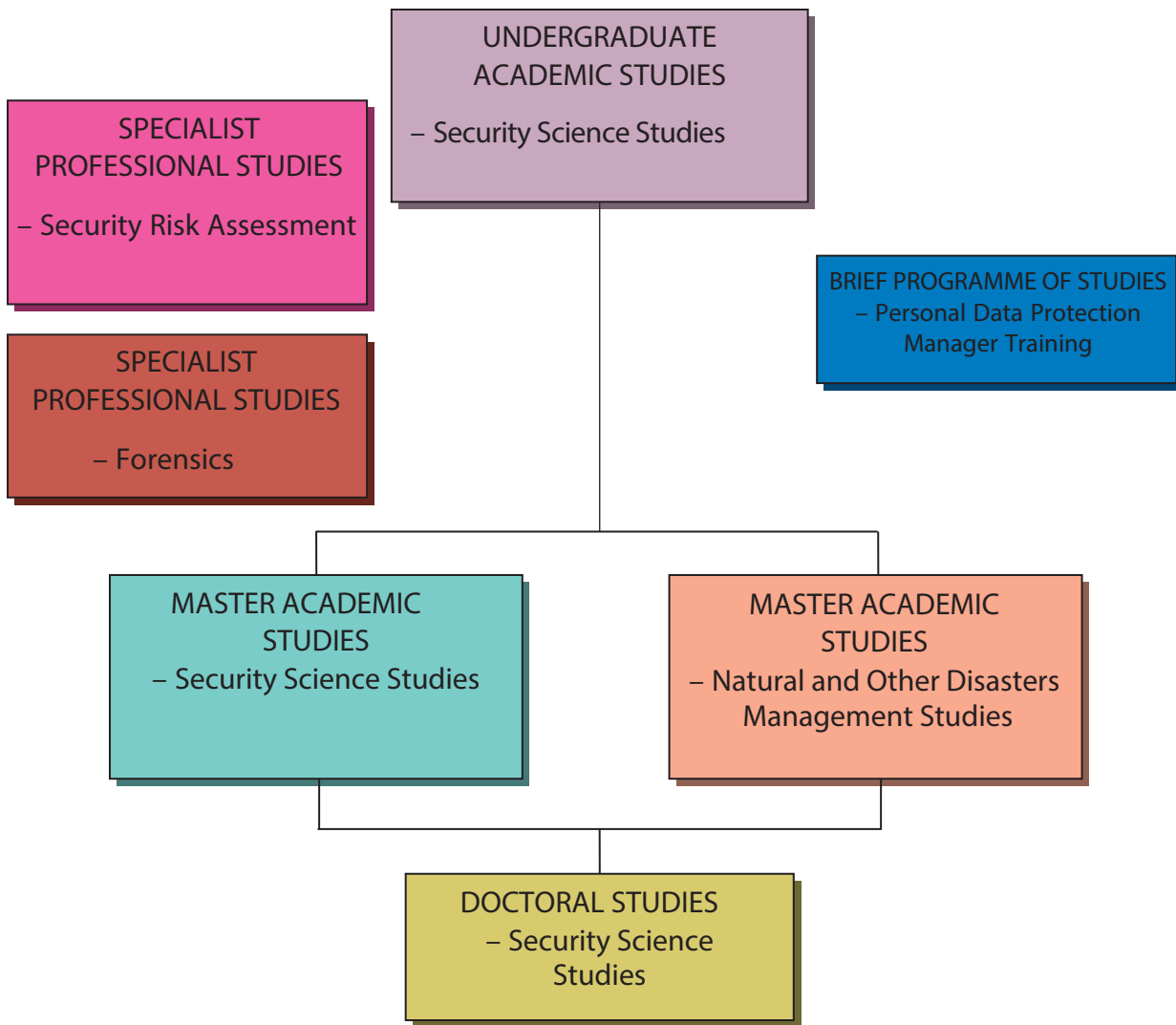
The epistemological status and use-value of security science contain theoretical and practical levels that intertwine and intersect. Security science combines certain types of theoretical knowledge about society and the state, which intertwines with skills or abilities from a broad field of management, conceptually distinguishing between *security problems* (“challenges, risks and threats”), *meaning and goals of security*, *security tools*, *subjects of threats*, and *security/protection actors*.

In that sense, teaching and research within the security science imply knowledge of various scientific disciplines: starting from the traditional fields of *philosophy, law, and history* (i.e., their numerous domains such as “philosophy of history,” “political philosophy,” “ethics,” “theory of law and the state,” “criminal law,” “history of civilizations,” “national history,” and more), through *sociology and psychology* (“sociology of politics,” “criminology,” “psychology,” and more), *political science* (“political system,” “geopolitics,” “international relations”), *environmental and civil protection*, all the way to organizational knowledge and skills of *management* (“crisis management,” “emergency management,” “human and social resources,” and more.).

Students of the Faculty of Security Studies come to the complete truth about the security of the state, society, and the individual through the study of logical steps of prevention and remediation of security challenges, (a) *analysis of the causes or reasons* of specific security risk and threat existence (assessment of the probability that certain events will occur, assessment of the number and type of actors, their interests and capabilities, as well as possible consequences of their activities; analysis of legitimacy and legality of the use of power/force by the state or private security, etc.); (b) *analysis of factors* that affect the perception and reflection of a security issue (moral and emotional factors; legal and political consequences; ideological motives and forms of legitimacy, etc.); (c) *control of the issue* to prevent the consequences of security risks, i.e., to eliminate possible other security threats (elaboration of potential “scenarios” of security threats and setting appropriate institutional responses, i.e. development of strategic documents, standards and protocols. These things are taught and learned at the Faculty of Security Studies.

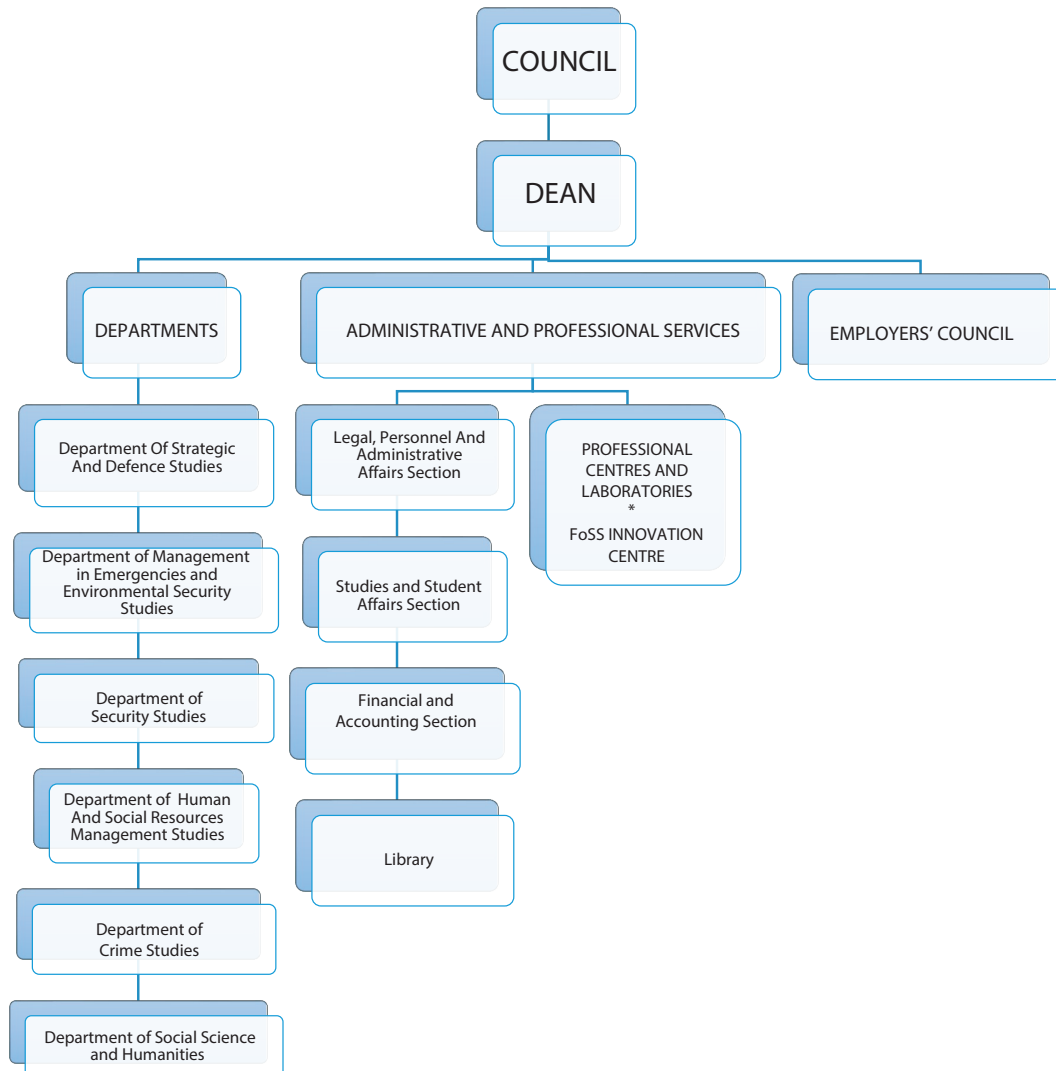

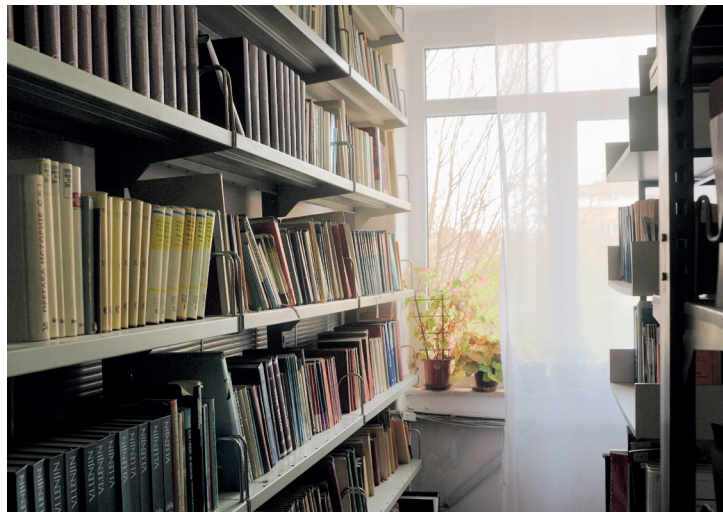
