University of Belgrade-Faculty of Security Studies, Belgrade, 50 Gospodara Vučića str. (hereinafter: the Contracting Authority) invites bidders to submit their bids in writing, in accordance with the tender documents and the invitation to submit bids.

Only bids that arrive at the address of the Contracting Authority and are registered in the archives of the Contracting Authority no later than until on the last day of the deadline for submission of bids, i.e., including bids sent by mail and e-mail to javnanabavka@fb.bg.ac.rs will be considered timely.

If the deadline for submission of bids expires on a non-working day or a public holiday, the last day of the deadline will be the first following working day, until 12:00 h.

Bidders will submit bids by mail, e-mail or directly in the archives of the Contracting Authority: University of Belgrade - Faculty of Security Studies, 11118 Belgrade, PAK 164905, 50 Gospodara Vučića str. with the following indication:

"Bid for Public Procurement:

PROCUREMENT OF SOFTWARE LICENSES, LOT (specify lot number), (No. JN-02/2022 - DO NOT OPEN").

NOTE: If the Bidder sends the bid by mail, it is necessary to state the name and address of the Bidder, telephone number and name and surname of the contact person on the back of the envelope.

If the Bidder submits a bid by e-mail, it is necessary to state the telephone number, name and surname of the contact person.

Untimely submitted bids, the Public Procurement Committee of the Contracting Authority will, after the completion of the bid opening procedure, return the unopened bids to the Bidders with an indication that they were submitted late.

Bidders that meet the requirements and submit evidence provided by the tender documents are entitled to participate in the public procurement procedure.

The procedure of bid opening will be public, held on the same day after the deadline for submission of bids, on the day of the year at the business premises of the Faculty of Security Studies, 11118 Belgrade, 50 Gospodara Vučića str.

Prior to the commencement of the public bid opening procedure, the Bidder's representative(s) are obliged to submit to the Procurement Committee of the Contracting Party an authorization to participate in the bid opening procedure on behalf of the Bidder, certified and signed by the Bidder's authorized person, otherwise, they act as the public and cannot take active actions in the procedure (signing the minutes, raising objections to the opening of bids procedure, etc.).



The Bidder may, in writing, request additional information and clarifications regarding the preparation of the Bid, no later than five days before the deadline for submission of bids.

The decision on awarding the contract or the decision on suspension of the procedure will be made no later than 10 days from the day of opening the bids.

The Contracting Authority³ shall reject unacceptable bids, as well as bids that contain substantial deficiencies under Article 106 of the Law on Public Procurement.
