Pursuant to Article 60, Paragraph 3 of the Law on Higher Education and Article 54 of the Statute of the University of Belgrade - Faculty of Security, Faculty Council, at the proposal of the Dean of the Faculty, at the treasury held on January 24, 2020. year brings:

### **Rulebook on the work of the business council**

#### **Article 1**

This Ordinance regulates the objectives, composition, selection procedure, reliability, manner of work, and decision-making of the Business Council of the University of Belgrade - Faculty of Security Studies (hereinafter the Faculty).

#### **Article 2**

The Business Council is an advisory body of the Faculty whose main tasks are: 1) improving cooperation between the Faculty and the economy in order to develop study programs implemented at the Faculty; 2) finding opportunities and ways for practical training of students during their studies; 3) development of innovation and commercialization of scientific research organized within the Faculty.

The Business Council continuously provides information to the governing bodies of the Faculty on labor market trends and needs in terms of knowledge and competencies expected from experts in the field of security studies, especially in the framework of corporate, national, strategic, and environmental security.

#### **Article 3**

The Business Council has a maximum of ten members, who, at the proposal of the Dean, propose the Teaching-Scientific Council to the Faculty Council, which elects the members of the Business Council by a majority vote of the total number of members of the Faculty Council.

#### **Article 4**

The term of office of a member of the Business Council is four years.

The function of a member of the Business Council is performed free of charge.

The Business Council makes decisions by a majority of the total number of members of the Business Council.

The work of the Business Council is managed by the President, who is elected by the members of the Business Council at the first session of the Business Council, by a majority of the total number of members of the Business Council.

Sessions of the Business Council will be held on the premises of the Faculty

#### **Article 5**

The Business Council meets at least once a year.

The Business Council discusses the adaptation of study programs of the Faculty to the needs of the labor market and the requirements of employers, considering more specifically the evaluation of extracurricular activities: training, courses, practical seminars, student internships. The Business Council makes proposals related to innovation and commercialization of scientific research.

The Business Council makes proposals and recommendations regarding the issues it considers and participates in the process of preparation for the accreditation of study programs at the Faculty, which relate to academic studies, specialist vocational studies, and short study programs.

The Business Council submits its proposals and recommendations to the management of the Faculty and the Teaching-Scientific Council

Upon completion of the process of accreditation of study programs, the Dean submits information to the Business Council on the manner in which the proposals and recommendations of the Business Council were taken into account.

#### **Article 6.**

This rulebook enters into force on the eighth day from the day of its publication on the notice board of the faculty.
